Format	Open invitation for all levels of play. Sanctioned events will be held during the day Sat. 04/16/16 for both men and women and include singles 501 and cricket. Non-sanctioned events Fri. & Sat.
Payouts	Guaranteed \$4000 payout for 206. Additional payouts added based on player and sponsor participation. For 2012-2015 events guarantees ranged up to \$3000 while payouts averaged \$3700+
Participation	The 2012-15 events drew about 100 players, ~40% were local. Players are expected from Roc, Syr, Buf, Alb, NYC, PA, OH, VT, Ontario, and more.

- Internet graphics (including most logos and other graphics from the web) are generally not of high enough quality to print at the required size.
- TP signs can assist sponsors with obtaining acceptable artwork from their existing vendors or work with sponsors to produce new materials.

Common File Types and Their Potential Impact on Sign Production and Output:

RASTER IMAGES



This logo image has been taken directly from a website.

Inappropriate for printing, this image would require extensive editing for any type of production. Note the jagged edges.

.png, .gif, .jpg



This image is a bitmap at an acceptable resolution.

This could be printed, however, scaling is limited and additional editing would be required to create a clean contour.

.bmp, .jpeg, .tif, .png

VECTOR IMAGES



This is vector artwork. It is resolution independent.

It can be scaled to any size without any loss of quality and can be cut via contours, as well.

.ai, .eps, .cdr, .pdf



This is a vectorization of a low quality bitmap image.

This image would result from the direct attempt to vectorize an image of poor quality.

No useable contours can result from such attempts.



Some vector artwork may contain overlapping shapes.

While this image could be printed, additional editing may be required for production ready art.

.ai, .eps, .pdf, .doc



This is a properly formatted vector logo. It has clean lines.

This image is ready for production.

It can be scaled, cut, carved, routed and printed with a contour.
